


# EARLY YEARS FUNDING

**Eligible** working families with children aged between 9 months to school age can receive 1140 hours of funding per academic year (30 hours per week during term time).

**Eligible** 2 year old children can receive up to 570 hours per academic year (15 hours per week during term time) if you or your child are in receipt of certain benefits, or you meet additional criteria.

**All** 3 and 4 year old children can receive up to 570 hours of funding per academic year (15 hours per week during term time).

**All funded hours are available from the term after your child reaches qualifying age**

A child born on or between:	Will become eligible from:
1 January - 31 March	Start of Summer Term (after Easter Holidays)
1 April - 31 August	Start of Autumn Term (September)
1 September - 31 December	Start of Spring Term (January)
